REQUEST FOR MODEST DRESS

Since the Mission La Divina Misericordia is consecrated land, the Mission has a request for Modest Dress when attending activities:

Please refrain from wearing: Shorts, Sleeveless Shirts, Hemlines or Slits above the knee, or any tight, low-cut provocative clothing.

Out of love and respect for Our Lord and for one another; all guests and visitors are invited to dress modestly.

Going north towards Canyon Lake on FM 2722 bear left at the fork in the road that leads to Startzville, before the “Stop” sign and then an immediate left on the road (with all the mailboxes) marked **Indian**

Chief Trail. Once on Indian Chief Trail, go all the way to the end, about a mile.
